

1. When you click the link to download the Uninstall Tool, the Brother End-User License Agreement will appear. If you agree to the terms, click **I ACCEPT**.
2. "File Download" will appear. Click **SAVE**.
3. "Save as" will appear. From the SAVE IN drop down, click **DESKTOP**. Then, click **SAVE** to save the uninstaller on your Desktop. This will begin the download of the Uninstall Tool to your Desktop.
4. Once the download is complete, "Download complete" may appear. If it does appear, click **OPEN**. If it does not appear, go to the DESKTOP and double click **DelInf_x.EXE** (ZIP is on the icon and .exe may appear at the end of the name).
5. "ZIP Self Decompression" appears. Click **DECOMPRESS**.
6. A message that the process was successful will appear. Click **OK**.
7. Go to your Desktop and locate the icon named DelInf32.exe. This is the Uninstall Tool.
8. Double click the **DelInf32** (.exe may appear at the end of the name) icon. "Brother MFC Uninstaller" will appear.



Note:

DO NOT double click **DelInf_x.EXE** with ZIP on the icon.



10. Verify your model appears in the box under "Please select the MODEL" and select your connection type (USB or Parallel) under "Please select connection type". Then, click **OK**.
11. "Complete" will appear. Click **OK**.
12. Restart the computer. The Brother Drivers have now been removed.

13. Unplug the power cord of the Brother machine AND the USB or Parallel cable before starting the Reinstallation Steps.

Note:

If you are a Windows® 95/98/2000 user, this procedure deletes both the USB driver and Parallel driver even though you selected only one.
